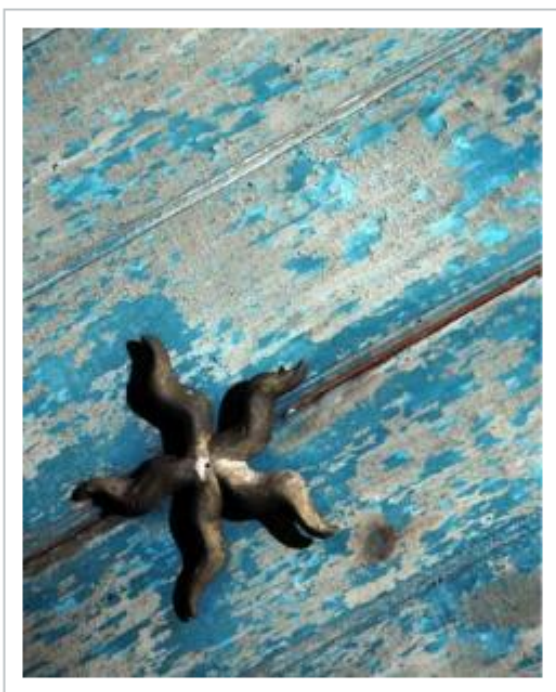

Final Gallery Talk In The Footsteps Of Weir

From: Weir Farm National Historic Site



What: Have you ever wondered what's inside the historic structures of Weir Farm National Historic Site? Here is your chance to catch a glimpse of what lies behind those locked doors. Join Weir Farm National Historic Site's 2012 Visiting Artist, Xiomaro, as he discusses his experience photographing the Weir House, Weir Studio, and Young Studio. Xiomaro was commissioned in 2011 to create a photographic record of the interiors of the buildings, in order to document the present state of the structures prior to the completion of the restoration project now underway. All three buildings are currently empty, which allowed Xiomaro the chance to focus on the details of these spaces -- features that might otherwise go unnoticed in a fully furnished setting.
