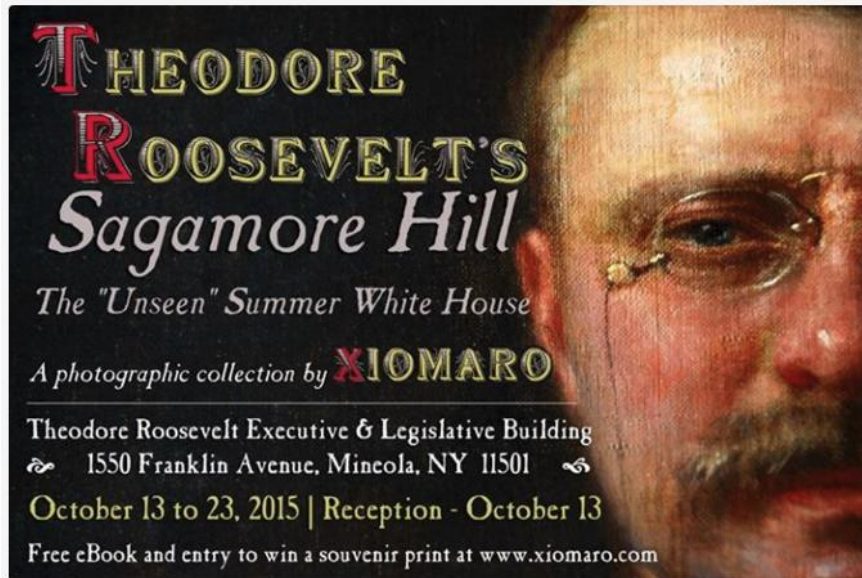

It gives us great pride to invite you to join us on Tuesday October 13th at 6 pm at the Theodore Roosevelt Executive & Legislative Building (1550 Franklin Avenue, Mineola) to open Nassau County's presentation of renowned hometown artist Xiomaro's acclaimed photography exhibit "Theodore Roosevelt's Sagamore Hill: The 'Unseen' Summer White House."

The National Park Service commissioned Xio to artistically photograph President Theodore Roosevelt's Sagamore Hill mansion during an unprecedented \$8 million renovation. His work is the first significant body of interior photographs since the 1966 black-and-white photographs at the Library of Congress, albeit with the interiors fully-furnished.

THE LARGE COLOR PHOTOGRAPHS SHOW THE INTERIORS IN A HISTORICALLY RARE CONDITION: THE 23 ROOMS OF THE HOME ARE VIRTUALLY EMPTY OF THEIR MASSIVE CONTENTS. APART FROM THESE IMAGES, THE PUBLIC WILL NEVER SEE THE INTERIORS IN THIS STATE.

This reception will officially kickoff a free two-week exhibition of the 40 photograph collection at the historic Nassau County Seat named in honor of the great American President. The building too has ties to President Roosevelt, including a bronze statue at the main entrance, mural in the dome's rotunda and the building's cornerstone, which was laid by the then New York State Governor in 1900. The white domed Classical Revival style structure is listed in the National Register of Historic Places.

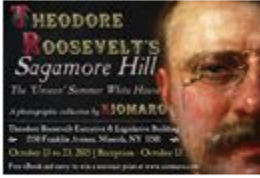
