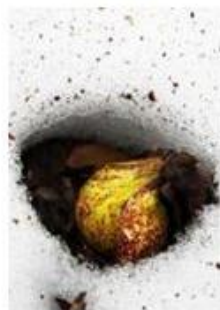

### "The Gift Of Weir" Gallery Talk

Join New York photographer Xiomaro  
on Saturday, December 10, from 2:00

p.m. to 3:00 p.m. as he discusses his creative process for capturing the winter and early spring landscapes of Weir Farm National Historic Site through his camera lens. As the March 2011 Artist-in-Residence, Xiomáro faced a landscape in transition. He set out to capture the beauty of the property, noting how his images "progress from the moody shadows of winter to the colorful hints of early spring." A selection of photographs from his residency comprise the exhibition currently on display at Weir Farm National Historic Site entitled *Weir Farm - "The Great Good Place."* The thirteen photographs in the exhibit "pay homage to the spirit of J. Alden Weir" and "celebrate the beauty of his homestead," a spot Weir called "The Great, Good Place."

Weir Farm National Historic Site was home to three generations of American artists. Julian Alden Weir, a leading figure in American art and the development of American Impressionism, acquired the farm in 1882. After Weir, the artistic legacy was continued by his daughter, painter Dorothy Weir Young and her husband, sculptor Mahonri Young, followed by New England painters Sperry and Doris Andrews. Today, the 60-acre farm, which includes the Weir House, Weir and Young Studios, barns, gardens, and Weir Pond, is one of the nation's finest remaining landscapes of American art.
