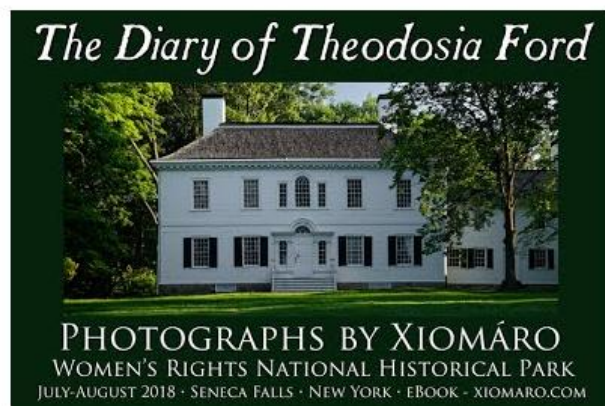

Morristown National Historical Park and Women's Rights National Historical Park may not, at first glance, seem to have much in common in terms of their themes. However, it does not take long before the common threads of perseverance by women are observed. Now, under the artful eye of photo-artist Xiomaro, the two stories come together in a special exhibit at Women's Rights NHP in Seneca Falls, NY.



Entitled *The Diary of Theodosia Ford*, the photo and narrative exhibit looks at the critical years when Theodosia Ford, widow of Jacob Ford Jr., hosted George and Martha Washington during the difficult winter encampment of 1779-1780 and the tribulations that followed.
