On Display: Weir Farm Exhibit



To celebrate the new book, ***Weir Farm National Historic Site*** (Arcadia Publishing), a select number of the photographs showcasing the park are on view now until **July 31, 2019** at the Mark Twain Library in Redding. The photographs were created by the book's author, Xiomaro, who is the Visiting Artist at Weir Farm and an alumnus of its Artist-in-Residence program. They tell the story of Julian Alden Weir (1852–1919), a leading innovator of American Impressionist painting, and chronicles his farm's rescue from residential development to its establishment as a national park.

The large photographic prints, measuring 17" x 25," offer immersive and detailed views of Weir's studio, his brushes, his home, and the landscape.
