The Connecticut State Capitol, 300 Capitol Ave. in Hartford presents "Weir Farm – Restored," an exhibit of photos by Xiomaro, from Oct. 3 to 28. The photos show the before-and-after restoration of artist J. Alden Weir's house and painting studio at Weir Farm National Historic Site in Wilton. The exhibit also celebrates the Centennial of the National Park Service. The exhibit will be in the Upper Concourse, the underground passage between the Legislative Office Building and the Capitol Building.
