■ **William Floyd's House of Revolution** This photographic exhibit debuts the first artistic collection documenting the Old Mastic House, which is part of the Fire Island National Seashore on Long Island. It was the home of William Floyd, an American revolutionary and a signer of the Declaration of Independence. Commissioned by the National Park Service, artist Xiomaro brings the Floyd house to life with 17 pieces. To Sun, 12/1.
